

All About Measure C

Measure C is the Mendocino Coast Health Care District parcel tax that was approved in June, 2018. There are a total of 11,120 properties subject to tax assessment for this district this year, with a total amount of annual revenue projected at \$1,601,280.

Since affiliation in July 2020, approximately \$6M has been received. Over the next six years (when Measure C expires), we can expect another ~\$8M from the parcel tax.

While it is an important source of funding for our hospital, Measure C represents less than 20% of the District's expected revenue over the next five years and will not be adequate to meet the needs for maintenance, improvements and retrofitting of our Hospital.

Dollars collected from Measure C have been used to make our community healthier and safer.

- A new ambulance for the hospital's emergency vehicle fleet
- CT scanner for the HCAC unit
- Building repairs and improvements, including but not limited to:
 - Roof repairs for our medical offices
 - Flooring repairs in the patient area and surgical area
 - 3D Mammography facility remodel
 - Lab renovations
 - Sterile processing renovations
 - MedSurg pantry repairs
 - New fire sprinkler
 - Installing safety & security access devices on doors
 - HVAC repairs
 - Door replacements
- Medical and lab equipment purchase and replacements, including but not limited to:
 - Patient monitoring equipment upgrades
 - Replacement Defibrillators
 - Gurney replacements and repairs
 - Generator repairs
 - Pharmacy refrigerator replacement
 - Vacuum pump replacement
- Upgrades to the nurse call system
- Fire Life Safety System repairs
- Infection control in the lobby, Oncology, ER waiting, lab and across the hospital
