She has expertise in managing particularly challenging dementia-related behaviors and awareness of family systems in the presence of chronic, degenerative illnesses. In addition to individual psychotherapy, she provides support, resources, education, training, and advocacy. She contracts with Redwood Caregiver Resource Center to facilitate support groups, teach workshops, assist with grant writing, and provide clinical supervision to master's-level social workers earning their requisite hours for clinical licensure.
